The candidate must display the ability to lead others and be driven to enhance the quality of life in our community. As a board member of Second Harvest Food Bank of North Central Ohio, Jimmy personified a spirit of volunteerism. The board of directors and staff of Second Harvest would like to give tribute to all of the characteristics that made Jimmy L. Davis a special individual.

This year nominations for this award should come from our family of Second Harvest Volunteers. Our volunteers contribute their time and energy to impact the lives of others. - Winner will be announced at the Volunteer Appreciation Dinner on Wednesday, May 2, 2018.
- Candidate must be available for the presentation of the award.
- The name of the winner is displayed on a perpetual award at Second Harvest.
- The winner will be recognized on Second Harvest's website, in the *Fresh Thoughts* newsletter, via social media and their name released to local media via press release.
- Employees and board members of Second Harvest are not eligible for consideration.
